The Mix is looking to recruit a new Youth Advisory Board to strengthen our existing Youth Voice Programme. The Youth Advisory Board will ensure that young people are represented throughout all levels of the charity.

The Mix has a strong youth voice network, with under 25's involved across all areas of our charity. Under 25's influence our support, content, and campaigns, and we also have two young trustees who ensure that young people's perspectives are represented with our board of trustees.

The Youth Advisory Board will make a direct link between our youth voice work and how decisions are made across the charity. Working alongside The Mix's senior management team and advising our board of trustees, The Mix's Youth Advisory Board will play a vital role in shaping the charities direction.

We are looking for young people to join our first ever Youth Advisory Board. You will be aged between 16-25 years old and be passionate about issues which impact young people and feel ready to advocate for young people at a charity governance level.

About The Mix

What is The Mix's Youth Advisory Board?

The Mix's Youth Advisory Board is being created to ensure a direct link between our youth voice consultation work and how decisions are made across the charity. The Youth Advisory Board will be made up of 8 under 25's who will represent the views and perspectives of young people at The Mix's decision-making level.

The Youth Advisory Board will work collaboratively alongside The Mix's senior management team and the Board of Trustees to ensure that young people's voices and perspectives are being heard across every level of the organisation.

The Youth Advisory Board will be made up of young volunteers with different skills, backgrounds, interests, and experiences. The more diverse our Youth Advisory Board is the stronger it is.

To start with the Youth Advisory Board will be responsible for,

- Ensuring the young people are heard throughout every level of the organisation
- Ensuring a diverse group of young people's needs are met through The Mix's annual strategy
- Establish a power-sharing model with the Board of Trustees and senior management team to ensure that the Youth Advisory Board's has a meaningful role and influence.

The Mix's Youth Advisory Board will initially meet 5 times a year in line with when the Board of Trustees meets, at present this takes place via a video call. Along with bi-monthly Youth Advisory Board meetings, our youth advisory board members will also sit on some sub-committees which meet before each board of trustees meeting. The sub-committees take care of a certain part of the charity such as finance and work with our Senior Management Team and Board of Trustees members to ensure that things are running smoothly.

Impact of being a Youth Advisory Board Member:

- Be at the forefront of ensuring that young people have access to vital services.
- Help set the direction of a charity which has a reach of over 4 million young people
- Ensure that The Mix's board of trustees are holding young people at the centre of their work.

Benefits of being a Youth Advisory Board Member:

- Learn vital governance and leadership skills
- Learn how a charity operates and what goes into growing a charity
- You will receive mentoring from people who are leaders in their field
- Will build up your CV and networking skills for future employment

Overall purpose of this role:

To work with The Mix's senior management team to ensure that young people's perspectives are considered in our strategy; and make sure the charity continues to meet the changing needs of young people. Youth Advisory Board Members will meet as a youth advisory board, and also sit on working groups which align with their interests to ensure young people's perspectives are represented in all of The Mix's decision-making spaces.

We do not expect Youth Advisory Board Members to have experience or ready skills in charity governance; you will develop these skills in a supported environment as you serve. We are specifically interested in young people who have a passion for advocating for young people's rights, understand the value of access to digital support services and are willing to speak up on behalf of young people.

Youth Advisory Board key areas of responsibility:

- Commit to attending 5 youth advisory board meetings a year and giving time in between meetings to various projects.
- Attend training sessions which will help you to thrive within your role in the board of trustees.
- In collaboration with The Mix's youth voice team carry out consultations to ensure that you are representing not only your own voice at this level but the voices of many young people.
- In collaboration with The Mix's CEO and senior management team lead the development of our annual strategy planning process.
- Be willing to bring your perspective to decision making at the governance level.
- Operate as an advisory board to The Mix's senior management team and board of trustees.
- Use your knowledge of youth-led activism and leadership to help inform the way the board of trustees listens to and works with the youth advisory board.
- Contribute insight to the shaping of innovative service solutions that meet the needs of young people.
- Champion the needs of young people and their involvement in the delivery of our services.
- Act as an ambassador for our work and make introductions where appropriate.
- Build connections and share learnings with other youth advisory boards and councils across the UK.
- Ensure that the insights from The Mix's youth voice structure, which inform strategy development, are interpreted correctly.

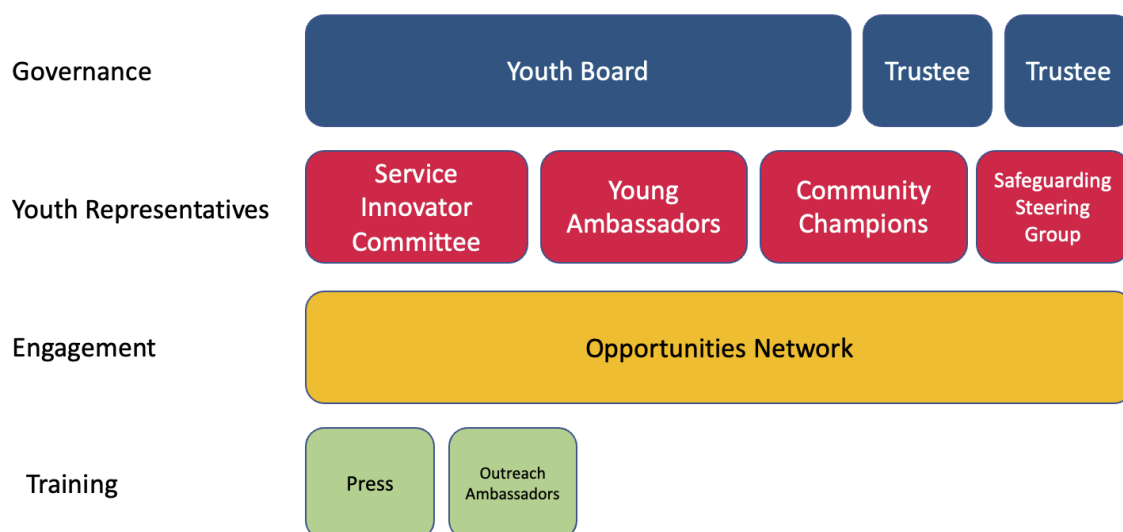
Time commitment

We would like this role to commit at least 18 months while we establish the youth advisory board. We envisage that the chair will commit the equivalent of about 10 days per year to The Mix, though we understand this may vary depending on your circumstances.

- Youth Advisory Board meeting bi-monthly – approx. 1-2 x5 days overall
- Sub-committee meetings prior to board meetings every 2 months - 1 day overall
- Ad hoc meetings as required, calls with CEO & BoT Chair– approx. 1.5 days overall

- Well-connected within the youth/ charity sector e.g., experience sitting on other boards/ councils
- Understanding or experience in volunteering, youth activism or youth leadership opportunities

At The Mix, we are fully committed to creating an inclusive and diverse Youth Advisory Board. A more diverse youth advisory board will:

- Understand better the needs of young people.
- Offer a broader range of perspectives about issues faced by young people.
- Be more creative in generating ideas and solutions.
- Improve decision making.

To this end we are seeking applications from individuals with a diversity of experience and perspectives, including age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, and socio-economic and cultural background.
